
Every accreditation application must be accompanied by a digital photograph of the applicant corresponding to the BAYOGOC photo requirements. A Pre-Valid Card (PVC) cannot be produced without an approved photograph.

Photograph must be uploaded into YOMS by 23:59 (GMT-3) on 24 May 2018.



The digital photograph must meet the following general requirements:

- · The person must be easily identifiable in the photograph
- · The photo should be recent (taken within the last six months) and with accurate likeness of the applicant
- · Facial expression must be neutral, mouth closed
- · Eyes must be open and clearly visible
- · The face must take up 70% to 80% of the photo
- · Face and shoulders must be centred in the photo and squared to the camera
- · The photograph must show full front view of the head with both edges of the face clear
- · Must not show shadows or flash reflections on the face and head
- · Classes are not allowed
- · Hats and head coverings are only allowed for medical or religious reasons if the facial features are fully and clearly visible.
- · Must be in color
- · Background of the photo must be plain white
- · All images should be submitted in digital format (.jpg, .jpeg, .gif, .png, .bmp)
- · The photo must have a file size between 50kb and 100kb
- · The dimensions of the photo should be 4 cm of width per 5 cm of height
- · The recommended resolution must be of approximately 300 DPI

Photographs that do not meet the described BAYOGOC photograph requirements, will be deleted from YOMS by BAYOGOC Accreditation and the NOC will be informed of the rejection reason. A new and correct photo must then be uploaded directly to YOMS by the NOC.
